## **DIPLOMA OF ADVANCED UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES (DAUS)**

and

### **NON-DEGREE PROGRAM**

A teacher holding a B.Ed., B.A., B.T. or any other approved undergraduate degree, may complete the requirements of an approved DAUS program or an approved non-degree program that includes 36 credit hours to meet the requirements for Certificate 5.

**Teachers must have advance approval from the Office of Teacher Certification for all course work taken.** Teachers must choose a DAUS program or a non-degree program in no more than two concentrations or in a teacher education program (i.e. Elementary Education, Special Education, etc.).

Examples of programs which are acceptable:

#### **NON-DEGREE**

Teacher's Certificate 5 Non-degree Program must consist of:

- 36 credit hours in total
- 18 credit hours must be at the 3000 level or higher
- 12 credit hours may be at the 1000 level. AICE courses are considered 1000 level
- the remaining 6 credit hours may be at the 2000 level

A person can take up to four Non-University courses as per policy 611 such as the NBTA courses provided they maintain the 18 credit hours as the 3000 level or higher. Therefore, one should not be allowed to take four 1000 level courses as well as four Non-University courses. The possible combination between 1000 level and Non-University courses are: 3 and 3, and 4 and 2.
