



## **CERTIFICATE 6 NON-DEGREE PROGRAM**

A teacher holding a Certificate 5 who wishes to obtain a Certificate 6 may complete a Non-Degree Program in order to meet the academic requirements. The program options are as follows:

1. 30 credit hours of graduate courses that lead to 1 additional major in a teachable subject.
2. 30 credit hours of graduate courses that leads to 2 additional minors in a teachable subject.
3. 30 credit hours of graduate courses that lead to 1 additional minor in a teachable subject plus 9 credit hours in an approved concentration such as School Administration, Critical Studies, Curriculum, etc.
4. Teachers, who have completed a Masters degree in order to obtain their Certificate 5, may choose a Non-Degree program at the undergraduate level as described for Certificate 5 purposes.

**Teachers must have advance approval from the Office of Teacher Certification for all course work taken.**
